The total package of sustainability measures for the Groenhoven complex will be determined at this meeting. This will then be called the Final Design. This will then serve as the basis for the so-called Technical Design.

This involves looking at how and when everything can be executed and requesting multiple quotes from different contractors. The Technical Design is likely to be ready by autumn 2024.

IThe proposed Final Design includes the following items:

- Frame, glass replacement and insulation cold bridges
- Insulating ground floor ceilings
- Solar panels for lifts, pumps and lighting Groenhoven complex
- · District Heating connection
- · Natural gas-free cooking on induction
- Concrete repair of Groenhoven complex

Owners can also decide on the following optional measures:


- Cavity wall insulation
- Making 'The Collective' more sustainable



District heating

On 17 January 2024, the owners of Groenhoven decided to choose district heating as an alternative heat source with individual metering. A good decision because it will deliver 59% CO2 reduction. Construction at Groenhoven, despite reports of Vattenfall stopping construction, can go ahead because the heat grid is already close by.

Less pleasing is that the cost of fixed charges has risen so much. Fortunately, heat consumption will be able to drop by up to 40% due to our sustainability plans. Moreover, there will be a new heat law in 2025 to protect us from excessive prices afterwards. Did you know that the soil around Amsterdam is suitable for geothermal heat for district heating?



You are the owner!

Every vote counts to get the millions in subsidies and the Heat Fund along to make your Groenhoven more sustainable.

In a decisive Special Members' Meeting in autumn 2024, we will have to ensure that at least 2/3 of the owners will soon cast their vote. 'Stichting Energiesprong Alliantie' will then also help with an activation team.

But owners themselves are also requested to help recruit, empower and encourage voting.
